

Beware of these Scam Techniques


Lately, there has been a significant increase in members who have fallen prey to scammers. The scammers convinced them they needed to send money to have a situation or a problem fixed that the member was completely unaware of having, because it never existed.

The best way to avoid being scammed is to not respond to any unsolicited calls, texts or emails you receive requesting money. Scammers fabricate a story about a problem that has serious consequences for you, but telling you they can fix it if you send them money.

Scammers can be very convincing. They are master manipulators at persuading you to send them your monev.

Warning Signs Signaling a Scam

When the caller instructs you to:



A Send them the money and after they fix the fake problem or situation they will send the money back to you.

A Not talk to anyone at your financial institution about the specifics of the situation as it could jeopardize "the investigation" and cause you irreparable harm.

CCU staff is trained to identify suspicious activity, and help members we believe are being scammed, which has saved many members from losing large amounts of their money. Keep in mind, once you send a scammer your money - it is gone! There is no recourse for recovery. You were duped by someone you didn't know but trusted.

You can help us, and prevent yourself from losing money, by answering our questions honestly.

We are always available to talk if you need help to determine if a request for money is legitimate. Stop at any CCU office or call us at 715-842-5693.


Congratulations August Winners!
