Our greatest renewable energy is our members.

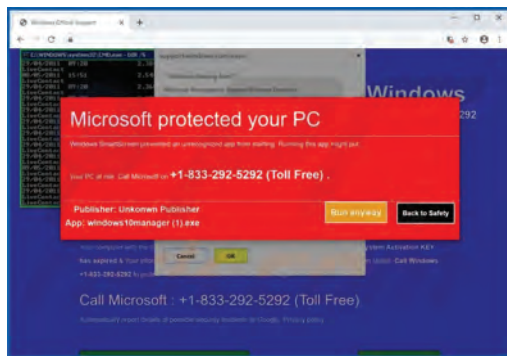
⚠ Beware of the Microsoft Support Scam ⚠

An increasing number of members are falling victim to the Microsoft support scam, and some are losing thousands of dollars. The scam starts when you get a pop-up message on your computer telling you Microsoft detected a virus or a serious security issue, but it's not actually Microsoft – it's a scammer. The message tells you to immediately call “customer support” for help, but don't do it! if you do, you're connected to a professional scammer. They may try to sell you overpriced virus protection. They may convince you to let them remotely log into your computer and take control of it so they can “remove the security threat,” which can result in giving them access to your passwords, online banking, credit cards, email and more. Everything they tell you is a lie that's meant to steal your money and personal information.

Warning Signs Signaling a SCAM:

- ⚠ Microsoft WILL NOT call, text or email you to offer unsolicited support, and they'll never ask you to pay for support using cryptocurrency or gift cards.
- ⚠ If you get an unexpected pop-up on your computer DON'T CLICK ON IT and DON'T CALL THE PHONE NUMBER. Your computer may already be infected with a virus or malware planted by the scammer so take immediate steps to ensure these threats are removed, either by yourself or a computer professional.
